

Each day thousands of patients search the national registry, hoping to find a bone marrow donor match. An estimated 750,000 Americans live with leukemia, lymphoma, or myeloma, and a new patient is diagnosed with one of these cancers every five minutes. BAPS Charities regularly organizes Bone Marrow Drives to increase the chances of connecting a donor to a patient in need.

NEPAL EARTHQUAKE RELIEF

On **Saturday, April 25, 2015,** a 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck central Nepal, while a 6.7-magnitude tremor was felt less than 50 miles from the capital, Kathmandu, causing widespread devastation. Strong aftershocks continued to hit the region on Sunday, April 26. BAPS Charities responded to an urgent call for disaster relief aid by working with recognized organizations actively leading recovery efforts on the ground.
