Blood Donation Drives

593 pints of blood collected
&
22 pints of plasma collected

1700+

The blood donation drives were conducted in direct collaboration with major organizations such as the American Red Cross and LifeStream, ensuring the supply was immediately integrated into the local trauma and surgical networks.

Preventive Health Screenings

Preventive Health Screenings were delivered through two primary channels: large-scale Community Health Fairs and targeted Clinical Awareness Sessions. These events focused on providing free or low-cost diagnostic services to individuals who may lack consistent access to healthcare.

The 2025 preventive health program focused on early detection of silent killers—specifically hypertension and diabetes—while providing the community with a clear roadmap for follow-up care with their primary physicians.
